WATER SERVICE INTERRUPTION

Atlantic Avenue between Norwood Avenue to Logan Street.

Monday, July 07, 2018 – Friday, July 13, 2018 (Each Day)

7:00am for 8 hours

WHY IS MY WATER BEING TURNED OFF? A water shutdown is necessary to facilitate the installation of a 20” water main in conjunction with the Atlantic Avenue Safety Improvements Project. It will occur at/or about 7:00 am and last for approximately eight (8) hours, **weather and field conditions permitting**. On occasion, this work may be completed earlier and water service restored. **You will receive a 24hr notice daily until work is completed, confirming water main interruptions. PLEASE LOOK FOR A CONFIRMATION NOTICE.**

SOME THINGS TO REMEMBER:

The DDC recommends that you shut off the water main valve in your house/building in order to avoid problems that may occur/when sediment enters or is released from your plumbing.

You are asked to shut off all WATER-COOLED appliances, which may include air conditioners, etc.

Once water service is returned, turn the main house valve back on and flush the system by running your faucets to sinks and tubs for about 15 to 30 minutes.
